



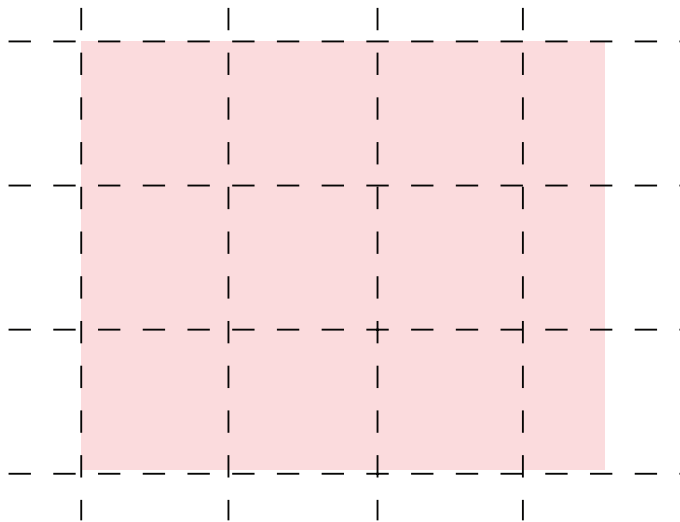
**This tutorial uses 6" squares made from Fat Quarters.**

Blocks can easily be made using any size square.

Works well with Layer Cakes cut into 5" squares . Two "layers" make 2 blocks.

# WHIRLIGIG TUTORIAL

Cut 2 contrasting Fat quarter into 6" squares  
You will only be using 8 squares from each Fat Quarter



Two Fat Quarters will make 4 Whirligig Blocks  
Each block requires:

- 2 squares from a printed fabric
- 2 squares from a contrasting fabric



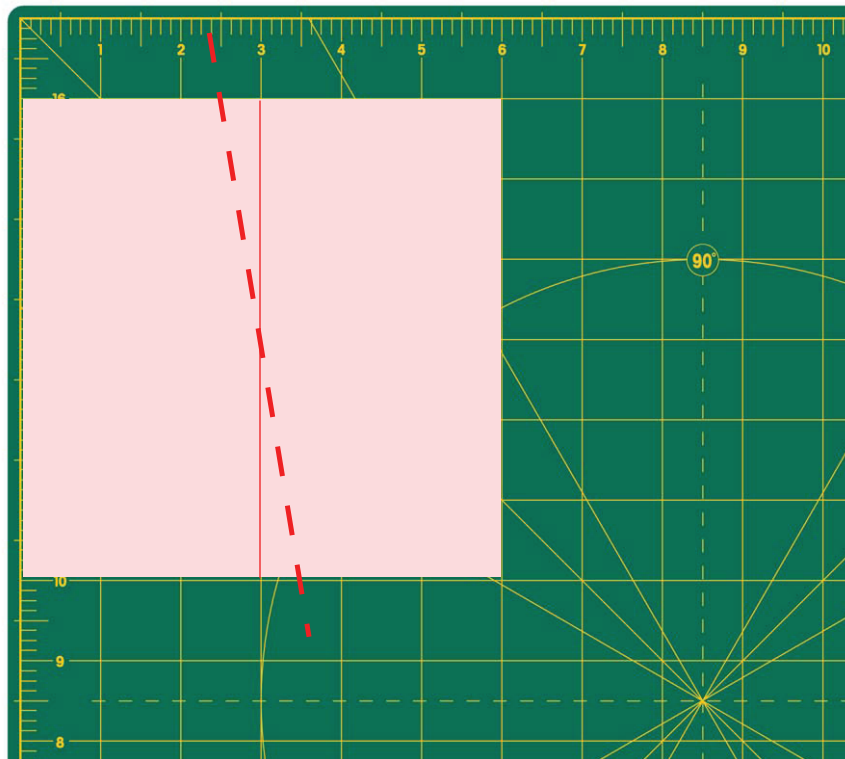
# WHIRLIGIG TUTORIAL

Stack all 4 of your squares together and place them onto your cutting board

Grab your quilting ruler - find the center line of your square

Line your ruler on the **top** of the fabric 1/2" to the **left** of the center line

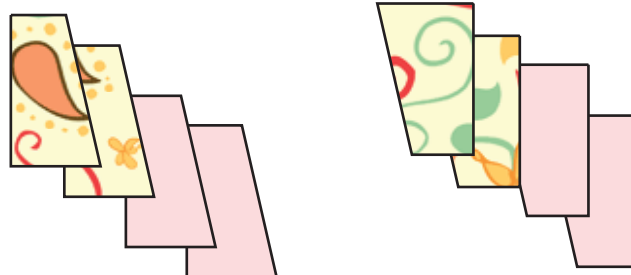
Line up your ruler on the **bottom** of the fabric 1/2" to the **right** of the center line



*If you are using a different size square be sure to find your middle line and measure correctly. The image to the left is for a 6" square.*

Double check your measurements and **CUT**

Keep your left and right cuts separated



# WHIRLIGIG TUTORIAL

SEW: Pair each left side with a right side cut of contrasting fabric.

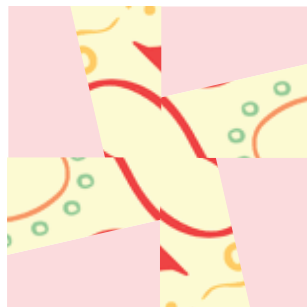


Lay the entire block out for reference

SEW: Left sides to right sides



SEW: The top and bottom together



WHOOOP! Whirligig!
