Fabric A (Green): 1 Yard Fabric B (Red): 1 Yard


Fabric C (Background): 1.25 Yards

A: Cut (16)7.5" Squares Cut (4) 6.5" Squares

B: Cut (16)7.5" Squares

C: Cut (16) 7.5" Squares Cut (12) 6.5" Squares




### **FABRIC CUTTING**

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#### **EASY HST**

- Pair 8 sets Color A and Color B 7.5" squares, right sides facing
- Pair 8 sets Color A and Color C 7.5" squares, right sides facing
- Pair 8 sets Color B and Color C 7.5" squares, right sides facing
- Draw a line diagonally on each pair







- Draw a line 1/4" off each side of first line.





- Stitch on the two outer markings, cut down the middle.

- Open, Iron, Trim the HST blocks to 6.5" square.








Using any ruler with a square edge, mark a line with washi tape from 6.5" to 6.5" lines. Align your stitch line on the inside.

Trim! This works for any size.
